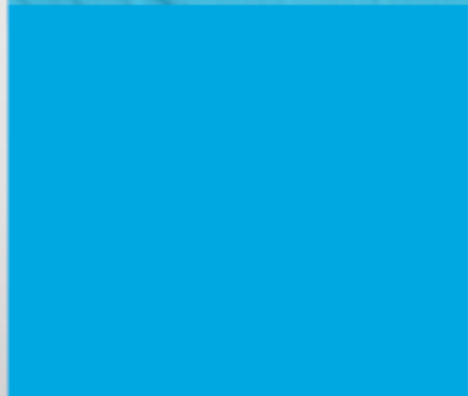

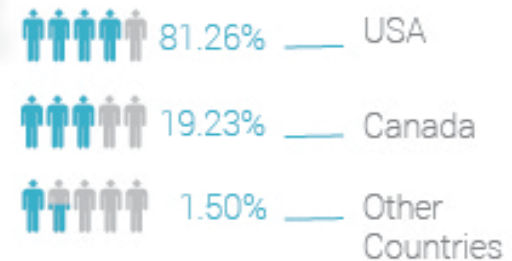

Guatemala held the "Pet Day" in the community of San Andres, Iztapa. A parade, songs, plays and contests with the local school children were part of the celebration.



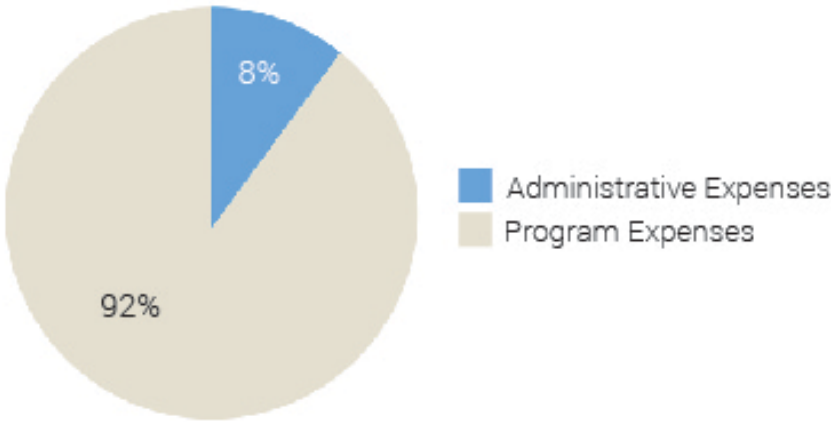

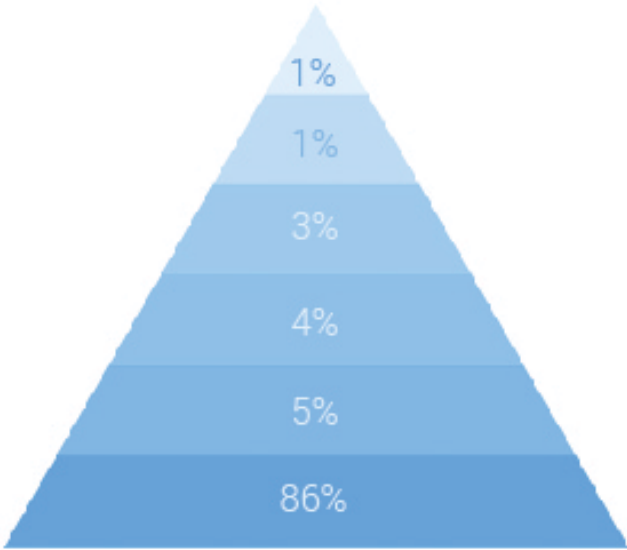
